Each fast-paced session provides science-based support to clean for health and safety and applied-science examples of processes that exemplify the approach.

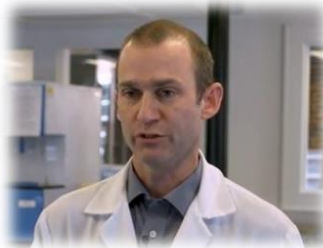

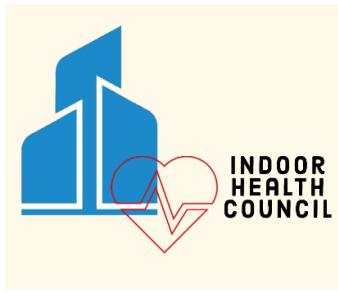
